





#### CULTURE CORNER TRAVEL IN VIETNAM

The main tourists hotspots are Nha Trang and Saigon! If you're looking for nature, Nha Trang is the place to go. It is most popular for its beautiful beach sides and waterfalls, such as Ba Ho and Fairy Spring. You can take a ferry and go 20 kilometers off the coast of Nha Trang to Monkey Island in Halong Bay. Yep, there are real monkeys!

The capital of Vietnam, Hanoi, has a train street with colorful buildings and street food. Hanoi is also surrounded with plenty of temples, colonial buildings, and museums. Take a walk on the famous Golden Bridge in Da Nang!

If you love the city life, you need to go to Saigon. Ride on a riverboat and sightsee the skyline and city. The tallest skyscraper in Vietnam, is Bitexco tower. Under the tower, take a stroll down Ngo Duc Ke Street known for being the city's "bubble route." The route features around 25 different boba tea and coffee shops such as, Gong Cha, KOI, and Toocha. Saigon has inside and outside dining shops with amazing high ceiling architecture and design. One famous café is the Vendana Restaurant, made with bamboo architecture.

Vietnam has a good mixture of nature and city life. Consider making Vietnam a future destination on your bucket list!
