VIETNAM'S 3 MAIN REGIONS

There are three main regions in Vietnam. the Northern (Hanoi), Central (Huế), and Southern (Saigon) regions. Hanoi is the capital of Vietnam filled with a mixture of different cultures brought in from the Chinese, French, and Russian influence. The famous rice noodles. Phở and Bún chả, came from Hanoi. The Central region is an attractive place for travel because the imperial palace of the Nguyen Dynasty is still standing: located right in the center of Vietnam. Saigon is famous for its luxury city life. Compared to Hanoi, Saigon has an urban landscape with wider roads and high rise buildings. Hanoi leans more towards traditional living including small alleys featuring traditional street food, and crowded motorbike streets!
